## PORT FREEPORT HOSTS 18th ANNUAL TAKE-A-CHILD FISHING TOURNAMENT

**FREEPORT, TX** (**May 9, 2018**) – On Saturday, May 5<sup>th</sup>, Port Freeport hosted the 18<sup>th</sup> Annual Take-A-Child Fishing Tournament (TACFT) at the Freeport Municipal Park. The tournament provides an opportunity for the Port and sponsors to give back to the community. Over 240 local young anglers with their families brought the total attendance to more than 600 people. With over 370 cans collected, the entry fee of a canned good helps fill the pantry at the Brazoria County Dream Center.
